Amélie Oudéa-Castera is the Minister of Sports and the Olympic and Paralympic Games from 08/02/2024 to 05/09/2024. Top-level tennis player until she reached the 251st place worldwide. She was the marketing director and then digital director of Axa France, then administrator and director of e-commerce, data and digital transformation of Carrefour, while sitting at the National Centre for the development of sport, then chairing the French Tennis Federation until his appointment to the Ministry of Sports. Barely out of the success and emotion of the Paris Olympics, she has just handed over the ministry to Gil Avérous, during an official ceremony on 23 September. Amélie Oudéa-Castera graduated from ENA and ESSEC with a degree in Sciences-Po. She also holds a master's degree in law.
