Former private equity expert and French politician, Jérôme Chartier is the founding president of Entretiens, an annual event launched in 2003 at the Abbey of Royaumont, aimed at intellectual exchanges and which has been internationalized with conferences in Warsaw, Madrid, New York, Madagascar and of course Mumbai. Mayor of Domont from 1994 to 2016, he was a member of the Val-d'Oise Parliament from 2002 to 2017 and Vice-President of the Regional Council of Île-de-France from 2015 to 2019. He has been involved in the drafting of many financial and trade laws, and several parliamentary reports. At the same time, he teaches at ESSEC and is the author of several essays, including Marianne's Lifting (2010), Éloge du travail (2013) and La démocratie des croyants (2023)
