French Philosopher



Monique Canto-Sperber is a Permanent Chair of the editorial committee of Les Entretiens de Royaumont, Emeritus Research Director at CNRS, philosopher, specialist in ancient philosophy – notably Plato’s and moral and political thought. She published many books translated into several languages, some of the books include: *La morale du monde* (PUF, 2010), *L’idée de guerre juste* (PUF, 2010); *La philosophie morale* (with Ruwen Ogien, PUF, rééd. 2017) and *La fin des libertés ou comment refonder le libéralisme* (Laffont, 2019). She was the director of the École Normale Supérieure (ENS) from 2005 to 2012, and then created and chaired the Université de Recherche Paris-Sciences-et-Lettres from 2012 to 2014.
